This will be a 2 day Khanacross at the motorcycle club, Charters Towers. Camping available (showers, toilets), There will be no food on site, so make sure you bring your own food, please bring your own drinks.. We will be using the old flat track, which is a smooth dirt surface.

WHAT U NEED;

8.2 Passengers:

(i) No passengers may be carried in a vehicle while competing, except where 8.2(ii) applies. Any offending driver will be excluded from further participation in the event. Other Competitors may be carried as passengers during the convoy run, provided the vehicle provides proper accommodation for such passengers.

(ii) Juniors may carry a passenger as an instructor **in non-competitive activity only**, subject to prior approval by the **Clerk of the Course** Any instructor must be over 18 and hold a CAMS and civil driver's licence and comply with the safety requirements for apparel including helmet and use of seat belt. Instructors must sign the appropriate indemnity form.

5.5 A fire extinguisher of at least 900g capacity, complying with Schedule H of the NCR (refer to Section 6 of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport) must be fitted.

6.1 Drivers must hold a current and valid CAMS Level 2NS or higher licence. No driver shall be under the age of 14 years.

Drivers between the ages of 14 and 16 must have previously competed in motorkhanas.

6.4 All drivers must wear suitable and appropriate footwear whilst competing. NCR 141(vii).

6.5 All drivers shall wear a safety helmet complying with a standard listed in Schedule D of the NCR

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Khanacross

TWIN CITIES AUTOSPORTS CLUB Inc

1. The event shall be held under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., the National Competition Rules of C.A.M.S, Khanacross Regulations, these regulations and any further instructions issued. This event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and risk management policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au . Insurance for this event will be provided in accordance with appendix 1 of the current CAMS manual.
2. The event shall be promoted by the Twin Cities Autosports Club Inc. The CAMS Permit number.
3. The organising committee shall be Kerry Cobbing, Greg Wright, Ken Whitby & Geoff Nichol.
4. The event will be a Khanacross and shall start Charters Towers Motorcycle club, Flinders Hwy at 1.00pm Saturday 4th July 2009 and finish at 2:30pm Sunday 5th July 2009.
5.
 - (a) Entries shall open at 10:30am on Saturday 4/07/09. Scrutiny will start at 11:30hrs Saturday 4th July 2009
 - (b) The Minimum Licence requirement to compete in this event will be a L2NS CAMS competitor's licence. Competitor who arrives late may enter for the remainder of the event. The maximum number of entries that will be accepted will be 30.
 - (c) The entry fee shall be \$70.00 for adults and \$30 for juniors
 - (d) The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS manual. Event Organisers reserve the right to alter, abandon, cancel or postpone the event in accordance with NCR.59.
6. The driver is required to be a member of a CAMS affiliated club. Documents to be presented at scrutiny include a current CAMS competition licence, CAMS affiliation, and CAMS vehicle Log book (if issued).
7. Competitors are reminded of Article 6 of the national motorkhana code and all vehicles must comply with Group 4H motorkhana vehicles. Vehicles must comply with noise restrictions, with fuel complying with schedule G of the current CAMS manual.
8. Results shall be decided on the total of elapsed times of the courses completed, plus any penalties. The winner/s shall be the driver/s having the lowest total, including penalties, at the completion of the event. In any case of equal scores, the ties competitors shall be declared joint winners.

9. Penalties shall be awarded for, wrong direction, failure to complete a course or failure to attempt a course, reversing after crossing the designated finish line, failing to stop at a mid course garage, failing to stop completely at the finish of a course, striking a course marker or flag. Protests if any must be lodged in accordance with part XII of the current CAMS manual.

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is not permitted until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR145A of the current CAMS manual. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcoholic or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hr notice to competitors, crews and officials. The CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such.

In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the Drugs in Sport Policy conflict, the Drugs in Sport Policy will take precedence.
