SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

The event will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. (CAMS), the National Motorkhana Code, Guideline for Passengers in Vehicles, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations that may be issued.

The event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found at www.cams.com.au

Insurance for this event will be provided in accordance with Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.

CAMS Permit Number: 409/2607/04

Event type: Multi Club Motorkhana.

Location: Townsville Dragway, Shaws Road, Bohle.

Entries open: 26th July 2009 at 8.30am and close at 9.30am 26th July 2009.

The maximum number of entries which will be accepted is 35. If entries are in excess of this number, they will be selected in order of receipt. Event Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

The entry fee will be \$50.00. Junior entry will be \$10.00.

General:

1. Drivers must be members of a CAMS affiliated club and hold a L2NS licence as a minimum.
2. Documents to be presented at Scrutiny include a CAMS Licence, current Club Membership Card, Competition Record (if issued) and CAMS Vehicle Log Book (if issued).
3. Competing vehicles do not need to be registered but will be inspected for safety prior to competing.

4. Vehicles must be fitted with street-type tyres. Off-road or rally tyres must not be used. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.
5. Drivers and passengers are required to wear as a minimum covered shoes, short-sleeved shirt and shorts whilst competing. Thongs, sandals and high-heels are not permitted. Drivers of Motorkhana Specials must wear helmets in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual; however it is recommended that all competitors wear helmets.
6. Competing vehicles must have at least a lap-type seat belt fitted for each occupant, and must be worn whilst competing.
7. Refuelling must be carried out in the designated refuelling bay. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.
8. No part of the driver or passenger may protrude from the vehicle whilst competing. Offenders will be given a 5 second penalty.
9. Passengers over the age of 12 will be permitted to ride in competitive vehicles after a disclaimer has been signed and will incur a \$5.00 administration fee. Passengers 12 to 18 years require signed parental/guardian consent.
10. During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).
11. The CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such.

In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the Drugs in Sport Policy conflict, the Drugs in Sport Policy will take precedence.

12. All tests will be from the Cams Motorkhana handbook, with some variations on distances to suit the size of the venue.
13. Results shall be determined by loss of points; the winner being the competitor who has lost the least number of points.
14. Penalties shall be awarded for touching poles, failure to garage correctly, failure to stop correctly, wrong direction, for touching boundary marker cones and time taken.
15. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.
16. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry or abandon, postpone or cancel the event in accordance with NCR 59.
17. Presentations will be made on completion of racing. Trophies/Prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd outright, first lady and first junior and 1st in class will be presented.
16. In order to ensure that the reputation of motorsport in general and the Townsville City Autosports Club Inc in particular is held in good regard by the viewing public, excessive burnouts or other acts deemed as hooning will lead to immediate exclusion from the event. Hooning outside the venue will be reported to the police.
